This model shows the right elbow of a male with individual muscles and the muscular origins and insertions on humerus, radius and ulna. For didactic reasons, the areas of the muscular origins and insertions are raised and color-coded (origin = red, insertion = blue).

The muscles can be attached to and removed from the corresponding areas of origin and insertion.
